Safety Saturday – Suggestions:

1. Move port-a-pots to just east of the main entrance, so people going into the building to use the bathroom may be diverted more easily
2. Have the Citizen’s Academy Alumni cookout for the PD volunteers and sell food to everyone else – burgers, brats, hot dogs, chips, soda, & water.
3. Stage a parking coordinator at the entrance for directing the presenters to their set up locations – someone other than Dan, so he can stay central in the lot for questions.
4. Urgent Care at Children’s will be open at 11 am in 2011
5. Need a possible costume change area and diaper changing area?
6. Get the free rock wall from National Guard – sign up for it early!
7. Get Flight for Life next year – make sure field is cut prior. Jason Shields is getting this booked for May 21, 2011
8. Get truck w/ lift from school district – Dennis is custodian from NB West. We could also use the trucks from the city garage, which have lifts on them
9. Need to double order of XS and S/M helmets – keep same order for L/XL

18. National Guard Rock Wall - min weight is 70 lbs - need to discuss if this will work for our event or if we will need to get wall from elsewhere
