FOLLOW-UP DISCUSSION RE: MAYOR GATZKE'S OCTOBER 13 CORRESPONDENCE TO ALDERMAN SCHEUBLE, FORWARDED TO CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

Ms. Crotty raised the issue of whether the Civil Service Commission had jurisdiction to take action on Mayor Gatzke's October 13 letter given that a civil service employee had not filed a complaint. Motion by Comm. Bubolz to take no further action unless it received a complaint directly from a civil service employee. Seconded by Comm. Kramer and approved.
