Fourth of July Commission Meeting April 30, 2003

f) fireworks – Cheryl will contact Paul Schoeneck re: invoice amount

g) children's entertainment – Nancy P. attended the Youth Advisory Board meeting and they request a time change for the High School Battle of the Bands from 2pm – 8pm to 4pm – 10pm, this is okay with the NBPD. Nancy Perkins moved to have the commission cover a sound system contract for no more than \$750.00. Jim Belland seconded. Passed.

j) concessions – Anida reported on concession meeting

l) main parade –John Z. received a call from Walter Roob. John Ziino moved to approve Milwaukee Banjo Band (\$425.00), Hoof Beats Express (\$475.00), West Allis Lancer Band (\$1100.00), C.L.O.W.N.S. (\$100.00), Spring City Squares-Waukesha (\$150.00), Tripoli Shrine Clowns (\$200.00), and Wiggles the Clown of Renoun (\$135.00) for the parade. Nancy Bertsch seconded. Passed.

--Cheryl will order the parade plaques – 1st-2nd-3rd places for each judged category and float categories.

m) grounds and parking and facilities – discussed motorcycle parking and will check on a couple of locations
