Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Common Council of the City of New Berlin, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, held on Tuesday, May 18, 1999, at the New Berlin City Hall at 7:53 P.M.

Licenses

"Class B" Retailers License

Motion by Alderman Bullermann to recommend to Council approval of the "Class B" Retailers License to sell Fermented Malt Beverages and intoxicating Liquor License for the year 1998-1999 to Diamondback Management, Inc., Joseph D. Maiorelle, Agent at Tumbleweed Mesquite Grill & Bar, 4900 S. Moorland Rd., subject to approval by the Inspection and Planning Departments. Seconded by Alderman Wysocki and carried unanimously.

Bartender's Licenses

Motion by Alderman Bullermann to recommend to Council approval of the Bartender's License for the year 1998-2000 to Dawn N. Gaulke, Stephen J. Ibsch, David S. Mangan and Lynn A. Willkomm. Seconded by Alderman Patzer and carried unanimously.

Property Maintenance Code Committee

Ordinance No. 2074 "An Ordinance to Repeal and Recreate Section 14.25 of the Municipal Code of the City of New Berlin Relating to Property Maintenance"

Motion by Alderman Wilkens to recommend to Council the removal of the last sentence in Section 3 "The role of the Board is to make recommendations on whether the violation negatively impacts the character of the neighborhood." Seconded by Alderman Patzer and carried unanimously.

Motion by Alderman Wilkens to recommend to Council that a City-wide mailing be done to notify citizens of the Property Maintenance Code Public Hearing. Seconded by Alderman Patzer. Upon voting, the motion fails with Alderman Wilkens voting "yes".

A Public Hearing was scheduled for the Property Maintenance Code on June 8 at 7:00 P.M.

Motion by Alderman Wysocki to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 P.M. Seconded by Alderman Wilkens and carried unanimously.
