***Citizen Awards***

Officer Fus, Lieutenant Mike Glider and Chief Joe Rieder presented two Citizen Commendation Awards to individuals who helped the Police resolve two crimes within the city.

***Minutes***

***Neighborhood Watch***

There are currently 30 official NW groups working within the program (this consists of approximately 500 members) and one non-official NW group (Weatherstone), which consists of approximately 500 members alone.

A meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 5<sup>th</sup> to brainstorm how to better improve the program. The city is broken down to 4 quadrants, which will be led by 4 individuals (Roger Wilde, Donna Froschmayer, Michelle Della, Open Position). These individuals will help knock on doors, make phone calls, etc. to give the program more visibility and improve communication with the Captains/Groups.

***Treasurer's Report***

Correction from November meeting *"This amount is to be adjusted by the money taken out for some pre-emptive devices and Officer Fus will confirm that new amount."* None of the money used for the traffic preemption devices recently installed on National/Sunny Slope came from the CP-donated Account. There is a possibility that \$1,000 would be used temporarily, however it would be refunded from the \$1,000 grant obtained from Walmart.

*Crime Mapping* – The website is getting better. It is still being worked on with some glitches but will continue to improve.

***New Business***

*Fire Department – Channel 25*– Jason Shields will discuss with Fire Chief Dobernig about including Fire Safety information a few times per year. Jason will also order additional "File of Life" packets, which citizens complete with pertinent medical and emergency information and attach to the side of their refrigerator. This helps Police and Fire when called to the home for emergencies.
