***Minutes***

***Neighborhood Watch***

Two meetings were held in the past month. Reflective address numbers were handed out to both groups. The New Berlin Public Library would like to get involved in a watch program of some type and asked the police to help them determine what is needed.

The committee will research to see if a new ordinance can be added to include certain size address numbers for each house in the city.
