VIII. The Board must start advertising for the June frofing tournament in area schools, libraries, etc. It was suggested that a large ad be taken out in the New Berlin Citizen. In addition, it must find chaperones and prizes for the event.

IX. The new Board t-shirts will read "New Berlin Youth Advisory Board" on the front, and "Representing the Youth of New Berlin" on the back.

X. Katie Levene moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:11 PM. Brian Moths seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.
