Present: Mayor Gatzke, Aldermen Bullermann, Wysocki, Patzer, Scheuble, Wilkens, Chiovatero, and Kaminski. Also present were City Attorney Paul Reilly, City Clerk Judy Weter, and Director of Community Development Steve Hoese.

UTILITY & FINANCE

Claims

Motion by Alderman Wysocki to recommend to Council approval of the Sewer Utility claims in the amount of \$48,211.80, Water Utility claims in the amount of \$50,026.51, and bi-weekly claims in the amount of \$136,071.15, all of which represents payments to vendors. Seconded by Alderman Bullermann and carried unanimously.

LICENSES

Bartender Licenses

Motion by Alderman Bullermann to recommend to Council approval of the Bartender License for the year 1998-2000 to Joseph R. Pond. Seconded by Alderman Kaminski and carried with Aldermen Wysocki, Patzer and Wilkens voting "no".

Motion by Alderman Wysocki to recommend to Council approval of the Bartender License for the year 1998-2000 to Samuel T. Laughery. Seconded by Alderman Bullermann and carried unanimously.

Special Class "B" Retailer's License

Motion by Alderman Chiovatero to recommend to Council approval of the Special Class "B" Retailer's License to sell Fermented Malt Beverages at Picnics or Gatherings to St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish at 12700 W. Howard Avenue from July 21, 2000 through July 23, 2000. Seconded by Alderman Wilkens and carried unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS

Recodification of Ordinances

Motion by Alderman Wysocki to recommend to Council to select General Code as the firm to contract with for the recodification of Ordinances to include placement of our code, after completed, on their website in a Folio format, 20 concurrent licenses, 5 hard copies, and 50 soft copies of the Zoning Ordinance, in the amount of \$21,961, to be done within 10 months. Seconded by Alderman Patzer.

Motion by Alderman Wilkens to defer this item. Seconded by Alderman Wysocki and carried with Alderman Patzer voting "no".

Official Newspapers

Motion by Alderman Kaminski to recommend to Council to designate CNI Newspapers as the Official Newspaper for the City of New Berlin for the next year. Seconded by Alderman Wysocki.

It was the consensus to have the Mayor send a communication to CNI Newspapers expressing the Council's concern of lack of news coverage in the City of New Berlin.

Upon voting, the motion failed with Aldermen Wysocki, Chiovatero, and Kaminski voting "yes".

Community Communication

Alderman Bullermann and Alderman Kaminski gave a brief presentation on the many mechanisms being made available to the public this spring and summer.

Motion by Alderman Kaminski to adjourn the meeting at 8:14 p.m. Seconded by Alderman Bullermann and carried unanimously.
