01 98 03 New Berlin West High School (18695 W. Cleveland Ave.) The County has put up some school zone 30mph signs. Hold on the agenda.

01 02 03 Katherine and Pleasant Dr. Request for stop signs on Katherine. We will hold this item on our agenda. Engineering did a traffic count to see if the intersection warrants any new signing.
