NEW BERLIN SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES

July 10, 2002, 7:30 P.M.

Meeting called to order: Called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Chairman Polczynski

Present: Steve Bartelt, Bill Dunn, Jim Polczynski, Ronald Schildt, David Schmidt, Jim Moczydlowski, and Jack Chiovatero.

Excused/Absent: Don Ullman, Randy Alf, Lynn Dahlvik, and Tony Goedheer.

Communications: Jim Moczydlowski was just appointed by Mayor Wysocki at the July 9, 2002 council meeting. We welcome him to the Safety Commission. Jim Moczydlowski advised that he was not Sworn in by the clerk's office. He will not be able to vote until he has been sworn in.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Bill Dunn to approve the June 12, 2002 minutes with amendment to drop the 5 before study. This is a typo error on the 2nd page under New Business. Seconded by Jim Polczynski. Motion carried 3 votes yes, 3 votes abstained, and 1 unable to vote.

Old Business:

010102 Cold Spring Rd. from Sunny Slope Rd. to 124th St. Revisit the issue of lowering the speed limit. Bill Frederick of the 13500 block of Cold Spring spoke. He stated that there was 34-access point on similar streets, but Cold Spring has 66 access points. He requested that the speed limit be lowered to 30 MPH. Also Mary Lemiranda a resident on Cold Spring was present. **Motion by Bill Dunn to recommend to Council to lower the speed limit from 35 MPH to 30 MPH. Seconded by Jack Chiovatero. Motion carried with Ron Schildt opposed.**

019803 New Berlin West High School (18695 W. Cleveland Ave.) Waukesha County has started to do the work for the turn lanes. Hold on agenda.

020205 National Ave. parking in the 16000 W. block, in front of Holy Apostles Church. This was a 1-time problem; Bill Dunn spoke to Sgt. Glider of the NBPD, and he stated he has had no further problems. **Drop from the agenda.**

010205 Moorland Road. North of I 43. No "U-turn. People are coming off the off ramp heading north then making a "U" Turn to go south. Ron Schildt reported that the State of Wisconsin will be putting in the traffic controls shortly, so we should wait until the project is completed. Hold on agenda.

010206 Signing of School Zones in the City. Safety Issues. It was felt that we should hold until Tony Goedheer is present. Hold on agenda.

109807 Wehr Rd. revisit the issue of lowering the speed limit on Wehr Rd. Discussion was held. Motion to deny and drop by Steve Bartelt and seconded by Ron Schildt. Carried unanimously, with the exception of one member unable to vote. **Drop from Agenda.**
