Approval of Minutes: Motion by Steve Bartelt to approve the minutes from September 11th, meeting. Seconded by Dave Schmidt and carried. Lynn Dahlvik and Jim Polczynski voting present.

Old Business:

01 98 03 New Berlin West High School (18695 W. Cleveland Ave.)

The School District is working on widening the driveways. Hold on the agenda.

01 02 05 Moorland Rd. North of I43. Request for a "No U Turn" sign for those vehicles that turn north and then make a "U" turn and head southbound. Waiting for county's work and further study. Hold on the agenda.

01 02 06 School Zones in the City. The Council has approved posting of consistent signing and the Highway Department will be working on posting the signs. Motion to drop by Jim Polczynski and seconded by Dave Schmidt. Motion carried unanimously. Drop from the agenda.

01 02 09 Weatherstone Blvd and Victoria Cir. Request for 4-way stop signs. Commission to study. The trees in the area do pose some sight distance problems. Commission would like the City Highway department to look at the removal of some of the trees. We will continue to look at the stop sign issue for improved safety at this intersection. Hold on the agenda.

02 02 09 Bicycle Path Safety. Motion to send this to the Park and Recreation Department. The issues that came to us were procedures, policy, closing hours and security of the trails. The Police will tend to safety issues as they arise. Motion by Jack Chiovatero and seconded by Steve Bartelt. Motion carried unanimously. Hold on the agenda.

03 02 09 158th St. at St Francis. Request for stop or yield signs. The Engineering Department and Police Dept. have studied the area. The amount of traffic, speeds of vehicles and accident data regarding this intersection do not warrant yield or stop signs. Motion to deny the request and drop from the agenda by Steve Bartelt and seconded by Jim Polczynski. Motion carried unanimously. Drop from the agenda.

04 02 09 El Dorado and Monterey. Would like to stop signs on Monterey. Vehicles speed through intersection. Commission will hold on the agenda for 60 days while the Police Department runs radar and studies the situation further. Traffic speeds, volumes and accident data do not support stop signs at this time. Hold on the agenda.

05 02 09 Regal Dr. by Regal Park. Request to place no parking signs on one side of the street, because when a soccer game is being played cars park on both sides of Regal and then there is only one lane of travel. Motion to send this to the Park and Recreation Department to study to see if a parking lot or bump out on Regal Manor would be appropriate. Motion by Jack Chiovatero and seconded by Randy Alf. Motion carried unanimously. Hold on the agenda.
