Communications:

Letter from Richard Bolte of the Waukesha County Dept. of Transportation advising that the County Highway Department will be placing tunnel visors on the traffic signals at National Ave. and Moorland Rd. (03 98 03). These visors prevent drivers from seeing signals that are not intended for them.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Ted Wysocki to approve the December 8, 1999 minutes. Seconded by Ken Czyzewski and carried unanimously.

Old Business:

10 99 04 3805 S. Casper Dr. City Hall sign is obstructing view of cars pulling out of the lot onto Casper Dr. Hold on the agenda for Council action.

12 99 01 Churchview Dr. and Moorland Rd. Request to re-name Churchview Dr., between Moorland Rd. and S. 157th St., because it may be confusing to emergency personnel. The Police and Fire Departments do not view this as a safety concern. The Engineering Department states that the streets are posted according to policy. **Motion** by Bill Dunn to remove this item from the agenda. Seconded by Jim Haggerty and carried unanimously.

12 99 02 Andrae Dr., 5610 south block. Addition of 25 mph speed limit signs and removal of "No Parking" signs. The Highway Department placed temporary stop signs here because of the parking problems caused when a model home went up for sale. The model home has been sold and the temporary signs are no longer needed. The Commission feels that the speed limit signs are posted according to policy and are consistent with speed limit postings throughout all the City's subdivisions. **Motion** by Don Ullman to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Jim Haggerty and carried unanimously.

01 00 01 Coachlight Dr., west of Carriage Ln. Posting of "No Parking " on one side of the street. **Motion by Ted Wysocki to recommend to Council that "No Parking" signs be posted 1) on the north side of Coachlight Dr. from the west end to the curve east of Carriage Ln. (1700 Block), and 2) on the east side of Carriage Ln. from Coachlight Dr., 300 feet north, and to direct the City Attorney to prepare the proper Resolution. Seconded by Bill Dunn and carried unanimously.** Lt. Alf will send a letter to the New Berlin Streets, Parks, and Recreation Dept. inquiring as to whether a parking lot could be created in Buena Park to alleviate the parking problems caused by participants in summer baseball activities.

01 00 02 S. Hunter Ln., from Camrose Ave. to Beloit Rd. Speed of vehicles; a concern that there is only one speed limit sign in that area. The Police Dept. will do a traffic survey. Hold on the Agenda.

01 00 03 Graylog Ln. & Graylog Ct. at Brookside Parkway. Request for "Yield" signs. Hold on the agenda for further study.

Motion by Ted Wysocki to adjourn the meeting at 8:00 p.m. Seconded by Jim Haggerty and carried unanimously.
