### Communications:

**Approval of Minutes:** Motion by Bill Dunn to approve the February 9, 2000 minutes. Seconded by Deb Schenk and carried unanimously.

### Old Business:

10 99 04 3805 S. Casper Dr. City Hall sign is obstructing view of cars pulling out of the lot onto Casper Dr. This item has gone to the Board of Public Works. Hold on the agenda.

01 00 01 Coachlight Dr., west of Carriage Ln. Posting of "No Parking " on one side of the street. A letter has been sent to the Streets, Parks and Recreation Dept. **Motion** by Bill Dunn to table this item per a request from Alderman Patzer. The Streets, Parks and Recreation Dept. may have future plans to help correct this problem. Seconded by Kory Hauser and carried unanimously.

01 00 03 Graylog Ln. & Graylog Ct. at Brookside Parkway. Request for "Yield" signs. Hold on the agenda. The Engineering Dept. will be doing a warrant study.

02 00 01 Cleveland Ave., 17400 west to Wehr Rd. Lowering speed limit from 45 mph to 35 mph. A request to lower the speed limit was made due to safety concerns relating to school busses and vehicles trying to enter and exit New Berlin West. A new church is going to be built east of Stigler Rd. and the baseball and soccer fields west of Stigler Rd. will soon be completed. Lt. Alf will send a letter to Waukesha County Director of Transportation, Richard Bolte, and the County Supervisors to request lowering the speed limit to 35 mph on Cleveland Ave., from Calhoun Rd. to Wehr Rd.

02 00 02 Buena Park Subdivision. Concerns about speeding and increased traffic due to Greenfield Ave. construction. Several concerned citizens from the Buena Park Subdivision appeared to voice their concerns about the safety issues in that subdivision. They would like to see some more stop signs, more traffic enforcement, and another way to slow the traffic down. Lt. Alf will have officers increase enforcement efforts and the Engineering Dept. will do traffic counts. Hold on the agenda.

02 00 03 Al Stigler Pky. Request to place "No Parking" signs on both sides of Al Stigler Pky. These signs were requested by the Police Dept. in an effort to increase the safety of traffic and pedestrians when emergency vehicles leave the Safety Building. Lt. Alf contacted *Superior Disposal*; they will not park their trailers on Al Stigler Pky. **Motion by Jim Haggerty to recommend to Council that "No Parking" signs be placed on the south side of Al Stigler Pky., from Casper Dr. to where Al Stigler Pky. turns south. Seconded by Bill Dunn and carried unanimously.**

02 00 04 Venomous Snake Ordinance. This is scheduled to go to Council, along with a copy of the draft of the Ordinance.

02 00 05 Moorland Rd., from Mark Dr. to Howard Ave. Addition of "Right Lane Not for Through Traffic" sign. Request made by the Police Dept. **Motion** by Deb Schenk to drop this item from the agenda as the County will be addressing this issue with traffic signals this August. Seconded by Bill Dunn and carried unanimously.

09 97 02 Calhoun Rd. & Beloit Rd. 4-Way Stop Signs-Revisited, per citizen request.

This issue has been submitted to the County. **Motion** by Bill Dunn to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Jim Polczynski and carried unanimously. Lt. Alf will send a letter to the concerned party and the County Supervisors.

03 00 01 Sunny Slope Rd. & National Ave. Pedestrian safety. This issue has been addressed by the National Ave. Corridor project. There will be crosswalks with pedestrian signal access buttons, a pedestrian refuge area between the east and west lanes, and about 5 or more pedestrian crossings. **Motion** by Jim Haggerty to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Randy Alf and carried unanimously. Lt. Alf will send a letter to Alderman Chiovaturo.

03 00 02 Prospect Dr., from 124<sup>th</sup> to 128<sup>th</sup> Streets Request for "No Parking" signs to be placed on the south side of Prospect Dr. The Commissioners will study. Hold on the agenda.

12 98 02 Mayflower Dr. at Regal Dr. Intersection Safety. Possible placement of stop signs. (Re-visited) The Commissioners will study. Hold on the agenda.
