Approval of Minutes: Motion by Bill Dunn to approve the April 12, 2000 minutes. Seconded by Jim Haggerty and carried unanimously.

Old Business:

01 00 03 Graylog Ln. & Graylog Ct. at Brookside Parkway. Request for "Yield" signs.

The resolution was passed and the signs are posted. **Motion** by Don Ullman to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Randy Alf and carried unanimously.

02 00 02 Buena Park Subdivision. Concerns about speeding and increased traffic due to Greenfield Ave. construction. Officers will continue to occasionally monitor for violators, especially now that construction on Greenfield Ave. is underway. Lt. Alf will send Ald. Patzer information on the Police Department's intentions for coverage. This item will remain on the agenda.

02 00 03 Al Stigler Parkway. Request to place "No Parking" signs on the south side of Al Stigler Pky. The resolution was passed and the signs are posted. **Motion** by Don Ullman to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Randy Alf and carried unanimously.

03 00 02 Prospect Dr., from 124th to 128th Streets Request for "No Parking" signs to be placed on the south side of Prospect Dr. The resolution was passed and some of the signs have been placed. Many residents from Prospect Dr. attended this meeting and voiced their opinions in opposition to the signs. Based on some of the information he's received, Ald. Bullermann is going to recommend to Council that the signs be removed. **Motion** by Randy Alf to table this item, pending future Council action and realizing that there is still a safety concern at Prospect Dr. and 124th St. Seconded by Bill Dunn and carried unanimously.

04 00 01 Edinborough Dr. & Oxford Dr. Request for "Yield" signs and/or more "Children at Play" signs in the area. There is a "Caution/Children at Play" sign posted on Oxford Dr. and the intersection is signed per Engineering standards. **Motion** by Bill Dunn to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Kory Hauser and carried unanimously. Lt. Alf will contact the concerned party.

04 00 02 Sandalwood Dr. & Ohio Dr. Request for "Stop" signs because of speed and safety concerns. The Commission's study of this intersection indicates that it is not a safety concern at this time. This intersection also currently meets Traffic Engineering safety standards. **Motion** by Jim Polczynski to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Kory Hauser and carried unanimously. Lt. Alf will contact the concerned party.

04 00 03 Calhoun Rd., from 4000 block, south to National Ave. Request to lower the speed limit from 40 mph to 30 mph. Based on the Commission's study and review, plus the fact that the area does meet Traffic Engineering standards, the Commission denies the request to lower the speed limit. The Police Dept. will continue to monitor the area. **Motion** by Jim Haggerty to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Bill Dunn and carried unanimously. Lt. Alf will contact the concerned parties.

12 98 02 Mayflower Dr. at Regal Dr. Intersection Safety. Possible placement of stop signs. (Re-visited) The resolution was passed and the signs are posted. **Motion** by Ken Czyzewski to drop this item from the agenda. Seconded by Jim Polczynski and carried unanimously.

07 99 01 Installation of OPTICON at traffic light controlled intersections. (Update) An update was given by Assistant Fire Chief Bill Dunn. The grant paperwork will be submitted soon. **Motion** by Bill Dunn to table this item. Seconded by Randy Alf and carried. Unanimously.
