

# Minutes

## New Berlin Safety Commission

February 10, 1999 7:30 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Dunn at 7:40 p.m.

### **Communications:**

Bill Dunn stepped down as Safety Commission Chairman and opened the floor for nominees for Chairman. Dunn nominated Jim Polczynski. There were no other nominees.

**Motion by Bill Dunn to nominate Jim Polczynski as Chairman of the Safety Commission, and to close the nominations. Seconded by Jim Haggerty and carried unanimously.**

Randy Alf nominated Jim Haggerty as Vice Chairman. There were no other nominees.

**Motion by Bill Dunn to nominate Jim Haggerty as Vice Chairman of the Safety Commission, and to close the nominations. Second by Randy Alf and carried unanimously.**

**Motion by Bill Dunn to elect Jim Polczynski as Chairman and Jim Haggerty as Vice Chairman of the Safety Commission. Seconded by Randy Alf and carried unanimously.**

### **Old Business:**

10-98 01 Meadowmere Pkwy. and Overland Tr. Stop sign request for east/west traffic on Overland Tr. Butch Powell was present at the meeting and gave views to place stop signs on Overland. (Such as, restricted view and the stop signs at Meadowmere and Glendale.) There are some large bushes on Northeast corner that does obstruct a clear view for southbound traffic. Jeff Chase does not feel it is a hazard if the traffic is adhering to speed limit and rules of the road. Hold on agenda for further study and further information from Ald. Ted Wysocki.

10 98 02 170 St. and Greenfield Ave. Resolution passed. Signs are up, drop from agenda.

10 98 03 Brookside Pkwy. and Glendale Dr. Resolution passed. Signs are up, drop from agenda.

10 98 04 Parkside Dr. and Parkside Ct. and Brookside Pkwy. Resolution passed. Signs are up, drop from agenda.

10 98 07 Wehr Rd. In 3090 south block. Safety concerns because of speed and accidents. After much discussion a motion by Jeff Chase/Steve Bartelt to reduce speed limit on Wehr Rd. from Coffee Rd to Cleveland to 25MPH. Motion carried on a 5 to 3 vote. Ted Wysocki carried it to Council. Common Council denied the lowering of the speed limit and sent back to Safety Commission. Commission will continue to study. Hold on agenda.

11 98 01 North La. at Pohl Dr. Safety concerns/ speeding cars. Hold on agenda until Resolution by Council.

12 98 01 Lincoln Ave. at 134 St. After discussion that the accidents and engineering data do not warrant signs the Commission decided to deny the request. **Motion to deny request by Bill Dunn and second by Don Ullman. Motion carried.** Alf to send letter to concerned party and the item will be removed from agenda.

12 98 02 Mayflower Dr. at Regal Dr. 4-way or 2-way stop signs. Possible removal of stop signs at Mayflower and Camrose and place a yield sign on Camrose. After discussion and the fact the accident and engineering data don't warrant signs the Commission denied the request. **Motion to deny requested signs at Regal and Mayflower by Jeff Chase and second by Jim Haggerty. Unanimously carried.** Alf to send letter to concerned party. Remove item from agenda.

01 99 02 Moorland Rd. at Mayflower Dr. Improve traffic flow problems from the subdivision. Discussion - There will be a left turn lane added to Mayflower for south bound traffic onto Moorland Rd. There are also two new exits/entrances scheduled to be added to the subdivision in the near future. This is already on the County's agenda for intersections to improve in the future. Remove from agenda for above-stated reasons.

11 97 03 Moorland Rd. at Grange Ave. (Revisited) Safety at intersection. Randy Alf to get accident data to Jeff Chase. Chase will send another letter to Bolte. Carry on agenda.

08 98 01 Mayflower and Mayflower Ct. The petitions received will be placed in Safety Commission files. Drop from agenda.

02 99 01 Greenfield Ave. and 124th St. Turn arrows for vehicles turning north and southbound. **Motion by Jeff Chase and second Jim Haggerty to remove from agenda. Greenfield Ave. Is going to be completely reconstructed in the very near future and this intersection will be corrected in that process. Motion unanimously carried.** Randy Alf to send follow up letter to concerned party.

02 99 02 Murray St. (5900 S. Block) Vehicles using as a short cut. Hold on agenda for further discussion.

02 99 03 Fire Stations. Warning signs for fire trucks entering highway. Hold on agenda for further study by commissioners.
