NEW BERLIN SAFETY COMMISSION

Meeting called to order: Called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Chairman Polczynski.

Old Business:

11 97 03 Moorland Rd. at Grange Ave. (Revisited) Intersection Safety. Item will be held on the agenda as Engineering is gathering further information.

02 98 01 Moorland Rd. and Coffee Rd. Turn arrows to be put up. In a letter from Bolte dated 6-18-98, Bolte advised that the intersection warranted the turn arrows. Apparently a new control box must be installed to get the turn arrows to work. Engineering is gathering further information. We will hold on the agenda.

02 99 03 Fire Station # 1. Warning signs for fire trucks entering the highway. Hold on the agenda for a response from Mr. Bolte.

03 99 03 Needham Dr. at 12800 W. Block. Unsafe Curve. **Motion by Bill Dunn and seconded by Kory Hauser to drop from the agenda. City Engineering has looked closely at the sign age and it is proper and in line with state standards.**

10 98 05 Casper Dr., Adjacent to Malone Park. Request for "No Parking" Signs. (Revisit at May 12, 1999 meeting.) **Motion to remove by Steve Bartelt and seconded by Bill Dunn. With the reconstruction of Casper Dr. (Wider roadway), parking will not be a problem. Motion carried.**

04 99 02 Andrae Dr. in the 5600 S. Block. Stop Sign requests at the 3-way intersections. More "Caution Children at Play" signs. **Motion by Ted Wysocki and seconded by Deb Schenk to remove from the agenda. Commission does not feel additional signage is necessary at this time. Alf to send a letter to the concerned parties. Motion carried.**

04 99 03 Cleveland Ave., 171st to Calhoun Rd. Request for "No Parking" signs. Safety hazard because of visibility problem. Carry on agenda for reply from Mr. Bolte.

09 97 02 Calhoun Rd. At Beloit Rd. Commissioners feel that this is not a safe intersection and should still be studied. Hold on the agenda for Commissioners to study.

06 99 01 124th and Graham St. The "New Berlin Hills Golf Course " sign at that location may be hindering vision of traffic on 124th. Hold for Commissioners to study.

06 99 02 I-43 Off-Ramp at Layton Ave./124th St. Safety concern that traffic may be backing up the off-ramp on to the freeway. Hold for Commissioners to study. Lt. Alf will have officers monitor traffic back-up for immediate safety.

City Clerk Bill Bowers addressed the Commission with information about the Open Meetings Law, the Open Records Law and Parliamentary Procedures.

Motion to adjourn by Bill Dunn and seconded by Steve Bartelt. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:35pm.
