NEW BERLIN SAFETY COMMISSION

Motion by Ted Wysocki to approve the September 9, 1999 minutes. Seconded by Bill Dunn and carried unanimously.

Old Business:

01 96 02 National Ave., 16300 Block. Traffic Control Lights. Lt. Alf to draft a letter to Mr. Bolte, Waukesha County Director of Transportation, to have traffic control lights erected.

11 97 03 Moorland Rd. at Grange Ave. Intersection safety. **Motion** by Bill Dunn to have Lt. Alf draft a letter to the New Berlin Board of Public Works requesting the installation of traffic control lights at this intersection. Seconded by Deb Schenk and carried unanimously. The County Highway Dept. will not put the lights in for about three years.

07 99 01 Installation of OPTICON at traffic light controlled intersections.

Motion by Jim Polczynski to remove from agenda as the Safety Commission has approved this and it is now in the hands of the people who can have it installed. Seconded by Jim Haggerty and carried unanimously.

07 99 02 Westbound I-43 off-ramp at Moorland Rd. Back up of traffic exiting I-43 on Friday and Saturday nights. Hold for further study.

08 99 02 169th at Greenfield Ave. Need for "No Parking signs" on 169th St. The signs have been approved. Hold on agenda until the signs are placed.

08 99 03 Tiffany Pl. and Condo Walk Path. Need for warning about pedestrian traffic. A letter will be sent to the Condo Association. And the item can be removed from the agenda.

08 99 04 Mayflower Dr. and Mayflower Ct. Removal of "Stop" signs. **Motion** by Ted Wysocki to drop from the agenda as the Council has voted to keep the signs in place. Seconded by Bill Dunn Motion and carried unanimously.

08 99 05 Overland Trl. and Brookland Rd. "Stop" sign request for eastbound Overland Trl. coming out of Lion's Park. **Motion by Bill Dunn to recommend to Council that "Stop" signs be placed for both east and westbound traffic on Overland Trl. at Brookland Rd. Seconded by Jim Haggerty and carried unanimously.**

09 99 01 S. Nicolet Dr., 5400 Block. Request for "Caution Children at Play Signs" **Motion** by Ted Wysocki to remove this item from the agenda as there is already a caution sign posted in the area. Seconded by Bill Dunn and carried unanimously.

09 99 02 S. 124th St. and W. Park Ave. Parking problem near the "Pendulum Pub." Hold on agenda for further review.

09 97 02 Calhoun Rd. at Beloit Rd. Commissioners feel this is not a safe intersection and should still be studied. Hold on agenda for Commissioners to study. **Motion** by Bill Dunn and seconded by Jim Haggerty to remove from the agenda as the Commission can take no further action on the matter.

02 98 01 Moorland and Coffee Rd. Turn arrows. Lt. Alf to contact the Waukesha County

Director of Transportation, Mr. Bolte, to check status.

04 99 03 Cleveland Ave., from 171st St. to Calhoun Rd. Request for "No Parking Zone." Vehicles pulling onto Cleveland from 171st cannot see on-coming traffic when large trucks park on the south side of Cleveland Ave. Lt. Alf to contact Waukesha County to check disposition.

10 99 01 Cold Spring Rd., Sunny Slope Rd. to 124th St. Request to lower the speed limit.

Hold on agenda for further study.

10 99 02 Cleveland Ave., Sunny Slope Rd. to 124th St. Vehicles are using the hazard lane as through lane of travel. Request "No Through Traffic " signs. Hold for further study.

10 99 03 Sunny Slope Rd., south of National Ave. Southbound Traffic turning into the Jewel/Osco lot. Should be posted "No Left Turn." The sign should have been posted. Hold on agenda until sign is posted.

10 99 04 3805 S. Casper Dr. City Hall sign is obstructing view of cars pulling out of the lot onto Casper Dr. Hold on agenda for further study.
