New Business:

SAYES:

Greg Bybee reintroduced the committees to "Say Yes". He distributed informational sheets on the program and asked for volunteers. Mayor Wysocki recommended that we pass the word along about SAYES and try to get them to participate. (SAYES New Berlin, Inc. is the Senior Advocate Youth Exchange Service.)

Old Business:

Teen Yellow Pages:

There are currently no updates that have been made on the Teen Yellow pages. Mayor Wysocki was given a skeleton on the Teen Yellow Pages and was informed on the progress that was being made. Tom Riese questioned whether or not we were getting any contacts or support from any corporations and that we take that into consideration when working on this.

Fourth of July:

Nikki Serkowski found the band Critical Pulse to play on July 3 at the teen dance. Both Tom Riese and Mr. Gatzke suggested that the Youth Board speak with teens at the dance to see what suggestions they have for us.

Youth Web Page:

Jordan Koscielniak said that the Programs Committee has not done any work on the Youth Web Page. Greg suggested that that all of the committees help out with the Youth Web Page so that the Programs Committee is not left doing all of the work.

Second Teen Dance:

Maja and Mr. Gatzke suggested that we plan a date for the dance to take place. Ashley Stocks recommended that the dance take place one week before school, on Friday, August 24. Everyone agreed to plan the dance on Friday, August 24. Mr. Gatzke suggested that we look into getting the north and the south wings open for this dance. He also mentioned that we should contact Blimpie's to see if they would be interested making any food donations, and that we find out what supplies are left over from the previous dance. Nikki Serkowski said that she could check with McDonalds about donating their orange bowl. Michelle Wagner mentioned that Morterson Photos might be able to sponsor us and possibly be able to make some donations as well. The Facilities Committee agreed to contact Morterson Photos. As far as marketing is concerned, everyone agreed on the entrance fee being the same as last time, and that we still allow \$1.00 off per can. Megan Mozina questioned whether or not we were going to contact Fun Times to do our DJing again. Greg Bybee is going to check with Mr. Brandt to make sure that the date that we have planned for our dance does not conflict any of DECA's plans. Karsten Huttelmaier mentioned that he was still in the process of writing a Thank You letter to the Senior Center and that he would complete the letter and get it out as soon as possible.

Relay for Life:

Chris Teerlinck mentioned that she left a message with Cheryl Schober, the Fourth of July Coordinator, on getting tents, and that she also left a message with New Berlin West principal David LaBorde for permission to use the sound system. Chris said that she already made contacts on using the volleyball nets, and that it's okay. Megan Mozina is going to contact the athletic director to see if we will be able to use the ticket booth and lights. Megan will also speak with church and/or school choirs about performing at the event. Mya confirmed that we have permission to use the concession stand. Greg Bybee suggested that we set a date to meet again within the next couple week and that the Agenda for the meeting only deals with Relay for Life. Mr. Gatzke suggested that the next meeting is held at his house on Saturday, June 2nd, where we can then commute to New Berlin West. (This was later changed to meeting at West's football field.)
