Motion by Commissioner Andries to further process eleven (11) candidates for the position of Police Officer for the City of New Berlin and be placed on an eligibility list in accordance with Police and Fire Commission Rules. Seconded by Commissioner Lorbiecki and carried unanimously.

Motion by Commissioner Brejcha to further process three (3) candidates for the position of Police Cadet for the City of New Berlin and be placed on the eligibility list in accordance with Police and Fire Commission Rules. Seconded by Commissioner Pedersen and carried unanimously.

Possible Action on Interview of Candidates for Promotions - Police and Fire Departments

Motion by Commissioner Lorbiecki to ratify Action Police Chief Dan Noordyk's recommendation to promote Detective Sergeant Philip Kiedrowski to the position of Police Lieutenant for the City of New Berlin. Seconded by Commissioner Pedersen and carried unanimously.

Motion by Commissioner O'Donnell to table the application to upgrade Fire Inspector Jason Schields to full time pending applicant's completion of Fire Inspector Certification class and the resubmittal by Acting Fire Chief Ron Rebatzke's recommendation for promotion. Seconded by Commissioner Pedersen and carried unanimously.

Motion by Commissioner O'Donnell to ratify the recommendation of Acting Fire Chief Ron Rebatzke to promote Joseph Pluta, Anthony Schwegel, William Spoerl and Mark Sura from Trainee Firefighters to rank of Probationary Firefighters. Seconded by Commissioner Brejcha and carried unanimously.

Possible Action on Application and Discussion of Appointment of Fire Chief

Motion by Commissioner Andries that the Commission appoint Edward L. Dobernig to the position of Chief of the City of New Berlin Municipal Fire Department subject to agreed upon conditions. Seconded by Commissioner O'Donnell and carried unanimously.

Motion by Commissioner Pedersen to adjourn the meeting at 10:48 P.M. Seconded by Commissioner Andries and carried unanimously.
