**Approval of Minutes:** Motion by Bill Dunn and seconded by Roger Hegeman to accept the August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2005 minutes as read. Motion carried unanimously.

### **Old Business:**

02 03 08 Parking concerns in front of Glen Park School due to the number of people coming to watch little league baseball. Motion by Roger Hegeman and seconded by Bill Dunn to forward the following motion to council for their approval. "Remove the existing no parking signs on Glen Park Rd. Place no parking signs on Glen Park Rd. in front of the school, from the south parking lot entrance to the school service road south of the school. Place "No Parking Here to Corner" signs 15' from each of the following intersections. Glen Park and Nettesheim, Glen Park and Butternut Tr. and Glen Park and Cedar Tr. (There should be 4 sign at each intersection.)" The purpose of this motion was to keep fire lanes and intersections clear for fire/safety equipment and allow space for people to safely park. Motion carried unanimously.

\*01 05 06 Grange Ave from 124<sup>th</sup> Street to Moorland Rd. Request to lower speed limit from 35mph to 30 mph and make that stretch of roadway a no passing zone in both directions. Motion to drop by Randy Alf and seconded by Bill Dunn. Work has been completed. Motion carried unanimously.

01 05 07 Moorland Road Safety Improvements (Waukesha County Project) Motion to table by Bill Dunn and seconded by Paul Rozek. Motion carried unanimously.

**\*\*\*\*02 05 07 Request for sidewalks on Moorland Rd. Although having Sidewalks would be better/safer than not having them, the limited space and the costs may deter such a project. Motion by Lynn Dahlvik and seconded by Bill Dunn to drop from our agenda. Motion carried unanimously.**

03 05 07 Request for no parking signs on National on the north side of the street between Moorland and 15700 west. Motion by Bill Dunn and seconded by Paul Rozek to send a letter to the Waukesha County DPW with the recommendation of placing no parking signs on the north side of National from Moorland Rd. to just west of the Car-X business. Motion carried unanimously.

02 05 08 Moorland Rd. and Beloit Rd. The concern is when cars are facing northbound in the westbound turn lane of Moorland Rd. The cars are turning before the median into the eastbound lanes of traffic on Beloit Rd. The commission will study further. Hold on the agenda.
