

LANDMARK COMMISSION MINUTES  
OCTOBER 18, 2007

1. Call to order by Acting Chairperson Ament at 7:02 pm. Attending were Commissioners Ament, Kampa, Pelkola, Adams, Hermann and Alderman Poshepny. Excused Commissioners Jashinsky, DeMoss and Wicichowski .

2. Motion by Commissioner Kampa to accept the September 20, 2007 minutes. Seconded by Commissioner Adams and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Kampa mentioned an interesting farm building at 124th Street between Howard and Coldspring that might be worthy of Landmark status. Commissioner Pelkola saw one on north Racine Avenue just before the horse farm. It has lots of trees. We should all take a look and see what we think.

We also discussed our Annual Christmas Party. We will talk more about who will bring what at the next meeting.
