

LANDMARKS COMMISSION MINUTES MARCH 15, 2007 MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Chairman DeMoss at 7:05 PM. Attending were Commissioners DeMoss, Wicihowski, Jashinsky, Ament, Adams and Alderman Hegeman. Excused: Commissioner Jackie Hermann.

Motion by Commissioner Wicihowski to approve the February 15, 2007 minutes. Seconded by Alderman Hegeman and carried unanimously.

Commissioner DeMoss passed around an Old World Wisconsin Day Camp brochure. She also passed around an updated Landmarks Commission contact list for WAHPC mailings.

Commissioner Wicihowski stated that the WAHPC dues have been paid for 2006 and 2007. \$500.00 has been taken off of the Budget and the Budget is now adjusted to \$1740.00.

Chairman Wicihowski reported that, weather permitting; he is ready to install the stakes for the Cemetery signage at Holy Apostles and will contact Diggers' Hotline and the business manager of Holy Apostles. Commissioner Jashinsky will contact Holy Apostles about the signage and when it will be installed.

New Business

- a. The signage for the Historic Post Office will be put up in the Historical Park. Commissioner Jashinsky will do research on the sign.
- b. We discussed the signage for the German Evangelical Protestant Church. Chairman DeMoss suggested placing the plaque near the road with the names of the interred on it.
- c. Chairman DeMoss talked about the Public Tour of New Berlin Cemeteries and suggested moving this to the Fall instead of May which seems too soon to plan. Motion by Commissioner Adams to table this to the next meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Wicihowski and passed unanimously.
- d. There was much discussion on the large quilt and outdoor sign from the razed New Berlin Center School. The large quilt will go in the proposed Community Center. The outdoor sign is badly weathered. Commissioner Wicihowski said the sign could be fixed and repainted. This could be a good project for Scouts or a school art class. The sign will then be placed in the Historical Park.

Commissioner Ament gave a report on the Historic Preservation Commission Workshop which she, Commissioner Hermann and Commissioner Adams attended in Madison on March 10, 2007.

Possible New Projects

Preserve areas so that new houses will blend in. Motion by Commissioner Jashinsky to designate Calhoun Farms as historic. Also look at Woelfel Farms and Kelly Lakes.

The next regular meeting will be April 19, 2007.

Motion by Commissioner Wicihowski to adjourn at 8:35. Seconded by Kay Jashinsky and carried unanimously.
