

Special Common Council Minutes April 17, 2001

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Common Council of the City of New Berlin, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, held on Tuesday, April 17, 2001, at the New Berlin City Hall at 7:08 P.M.

Mayor Gatzke called the meeting to order. Present were Aldermen Bullermann, Wysocki, Patzer, Scheuble, Wilkens, Chiovero, and Kaminski. Also present were Asst. A vote was taken, Alderman Bullermann received 3 votes, Alderman Scheuble received 3 votes. Mayor Wysocki voted for Alderman Bullermann, Alderman Bullermann is elected Council President.

Motion by Alderman Wilkens to adjourn the meeting at 8:34 p.m. Seconded by Alderman Chiovero and carried unanimously.
