

**NEW BERLIN SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES**

**Meeting called to order:** Called to order at 6:32p.m. by Chairman Steve Bartelt.

**Approval of Minutes:** Motion by Don Ullman to approve the minutes from the December 10<sup>th</sup> meeting as presented, seconded by Jim Moczydlowski and carried.

**Old Business:**

04 03 07      Beloit Road at Emmer Drive. Request for visibility check. A letter was sent to the landowner in December, but there has been no response. The consensus of the commission is that vision is not impaired in the sight triangle. **Motion by Don Ullman to drop from the agenda. Seconded by Ron Schildt. Motion carried.**

02 03 08      No Parking on Glen Park by the school. Jack Chiovatero will take the commission recommendation to council to allow parking on the east side of Glen Park, from Butternut Tr. to Redwood Tr. (Note: Some no parking signs just south of Butternut Tr. will have to be removed.) Hold on agenda.

01 03 10      Request for "No Parking" signs on Lagoon. The commission's consensus was that there is not a parking problem on Lagoon. **Motion by Bill Dunn to deny the request and drop from the agenda. Second by Jim Moczydlowski. Motion carried.**

02 03 10      Safety concerns regarding children crossing Sunny Slope Rd. to and from Eisenhower High School. **Motion to deny the request and drop from the agenda by Jim Moczydlowski and seconded by Tony Goedheer.** Reasons for the denial were; The New Berlin Public School Board policy to bus all students, creating a hazard due to having no sidewalks and not having money to hire crossing guards and to perform the necessary work. **Motion carried. Drop from the agenda.**

01 03 11 Highpointe and National. Cars for sale parked on Highpointe south of National Ave. The City already has an ordinance that that has to do with line of sight at intersections and that there is to be no parking with in 75 feet of a stop sign. **Motion by Jack Chiovatero and seconded by Don Ullman to place a “No Parking” sign saying, “No Parking Here to Corner” that is 75 feet south of the stop sign at Highpointe and National. Motion carried and the DPW will place the sign.** Hold on the Agenda.

**Tabled Items:**

01 03 09 Poplar Creek School. By-pass lane/right turn lane for eastbound traffic on Cleveland in front of the school. Tony Goedheer reports this work is scheduled to be done during the parking lot paving phase after the schools current construction is completed. **Motion to table this item by Bill Dunn and seconded by Ron Schildt. Motion carried.**
