Old Business:

- 01 04 02 Request for cautionary signs warning of emergency vehicles entering on to National Ave, Casper Dr. and Al Stigler PKWY. **Motion by Bill Dunn to move to old business. Seconded by Lynn Dahlvik and carried unanimously.** Mr. Joseph Lewandowski of New Berlin shared his thoughts that instead of signs a signal should be put in. **Motion by Bill Dunn to drop from the agenda as the County DPW has posted the signs. Seconded by Paul Rozek and carried unanimously. Drop from the agenda.**
- 01 04 04 Request to lower the speed limit on Small Rd. **Motion by Lynn Dahlvik to drop from the agenda as the resolution has been approved by the Common Council and the road has been posted. Seconded by Roger Hegeman and carried unanimously. Drop from the agenda.**
- 01 03 09 Poplar Creek School. By-pass lane/right turn lane for eastbound traffic on Cleveland in front of the school. **Motion by Lynn to drop from the agenda as the roadwork has been completed. Seconded by Paul Rozek and carried unanimously. Drop from the agenda.**
- 04 04 06 Robin Rd. 15600 to 15700. Seconded by Bill Dunn and carried unanimously. Drop from the agenda.**

05 04 06 Glengarry at National. Safety issues for vehicles entering and exiting the first drive west of National on Glengarry Rd. on the north side of Glengarry. Commissioners will study. Hold on the agenda.

06 04 06 Streetlights. National Ave at Summerland Ct. and Rose Ct. The commission will hold on the agenda for further information.

01 04 07 Racine Ave. and Lawnsdale Rd. Safety improvements at this intersection due to fatal accidents. Commissioners to study, hold on the agenda.

02 04 07 Sunny Slope Rd. south of National. Citizen feels traffic is going to fast and also concerned about the large trucks going to Jewel. Commissioners will review the area. Hold on the agenda.
