Approval of Minutes: Ron Schildt corrected an error from the minutes of the April 19th, 2003 meeting under "New Business 01 03 04" which mentioned that a letter would be sent to the county. The letter was actually sent to the state. Motion by Dave Schmidt to approve the minutes from April 19th, 2003 meeting with that one correction noted. Seconded by Jim Moczydlowski and carried.

Old Business:

- 02 02 11 I-43. Signing of roadways that go under or over I-43. Work has been started on this project. Hold on the agenda at this time.
- 03 02 11 I-43. Safety fences on the I-43 bridges. We have not received a final response from the State Department of Transportation yet. Hold on the agenda at this time.
- 01 03 04 Elm Grove Road at Greenfield Avenue. Southbound traffic is turning into the northbound lane. Request for better signing or markings. A letter has been sent to the State Department of Transportation requesting a skip line for westbound Greenfield turning south onto Elm Grove Road. It was also requested that the median be painted yellow. Hold on the agenda at this time.

Tabled Items:

- 01 98 03 New Berlin West (18695 W. Cleveland Ave.) Traffic accidents and safety concerns. Construction will begin June 16, 2003 on both the east and west driveways. Both driveways will be widened to three full lanes. Hold on the agenda.
- 02 02 09 Bicycle Path Safety. Bike patrol officers will be patrolling the bike trails looking for any type of violations and talking with area residents about any concerns they may have about the safety of the bike paths. Mike Glider will report their results at the June meeting. Hold on the agenda.
