UTILITY & FINANCE

Claims

Motion by Alderman Bullermann to recommend to Council approval of payment of Water Utility Claims in the amount of \$32,778.21, Sewer Utility Claims in the amount of \$278,417.28, and Bi-weekly Claims in the amount of \$434,627.48, all of which represents payments to vendors. Seconded by Alderman Chiovero and carried unanimously.

LICENSES

Bartender Licenses

Motion by Alderman Scheuble to recommend to Council approval of a 6-month Bartender License to Tracey L. Zettel. Seconded by Alderman Bullermann.

Alderman Scheuble withdrew his motion.

Motion by Alderman Scheuble to recommend to Council approval of the Bartender License for the year 2000-2002 to Tracey L. Zettel. Seconded by Alderman Bullermann and carried with Aldermen Thomas, Wilkens and Chiovero voting "no".

Motion by Alderman Wilkens to recommend to Council approval of a Bartender License for the year 2000-2002 to Jason A. Rockenfield. Seconded by Alderman Gallagher. Upon voting, the motion failed with Aldermen Gallagher, Scheuble, and Wilkens voting "yes".

Motion by Alderman Bullermann to recommend to Council approval of the Bartender Licenses for the year 2000-2002 to Mark A. Dilley, Derrick D. Douglas, Ronald L. Kotlarek, Douglas C. Rullmann, Todd M. Szmania, Brian J. Tessmann, Curtiss J. Youngberg and Nikki J. Zbichorski. Seconded by Alderman Chiovero and carried unanimously.

Amendment to "Class B" Retailers License

Motion by Alderman Wilkens to recommend to Council approval of the amendment to the "Class B" Retailers License to include the "Parking Lot Area" for West Side Pub, 20385 West National Avenue, on Saturday, June 23, 2001 from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. (Live music from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.). Any complaints from neighbors, etc. that require police response will result in immediate revocation of outdoor amendment and/or live music. Seconded by Alderman Bullermann and carried unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS

Purchase of Pickup Truck for Engineering Division

Motion by Alderman Bullermann to recommend to Council the expenditure of \$19,725 for the purchase of a 2001 Ford 4X4 pickup truck for use by the Engineering Division. Funding for this purchase is from surplus 2001 CIP account (252-360) rubber-tired front-end loader. Seconded by Alderman Wilkens.

Motion by Alderman Scheuble to amend the motion and approve the purchase of a 4X4 pickup truck for the purposes of buying a used vehicle to get the best deal possible, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000. Seconded by Alderman Wilkens.

Alderman Scheuble withdrew his amendment.

Upon voting on the original motion, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Alderman Bullermann to adjourn the meeting at 7:26 p.m. Seconded by Alderman Wilkens and carried unanimously.
