Claims

Motion by Alderman Bullermann to recommend to Council approval of payment of Water Utility Claims in the amount of \$113,847.10; Sewer Utility Claims in the amount of \$592,221.24, of that amount \$256,292.04 represents payment to MMSD, and the remaining amount of \$335,929.20 represents payments to vendors; and Bi-weekly Claims in the amount of \$261,732.50, all of which represents payments to vendors.
