#### Claims

#### Amendment to "Class B" Retailers License

Motion by Alderman Wilkens to recommend to Council approval of the amendment to the "Class B" Retailers License to include the "Parking Lot Area" for Matty's Bar & Grille, 14460 W. College Ave., on Friday, August 16, 2002 from 3:00 PM to 1:00 AM, Saturday, August 17, 2002 from 2:00 PM to 1:00 AM, and Sunday, August 18, 2002 from 2:00 PM to 1:00 AM. (Live music on Friday from 8:00 PM to 12:00 AM, Saturday from 1:00 PM to 12:00 AM and Sunday from 1:00 PM to 11:00 PM). Any complaints from neighbors, etc. that require police response will result in immediate revocation of outdoor amendment and/or live music. Seconded by Alderman Bullermann and carried with Alderman Gallagher voting "no".

**New Berlin's Annual Historic Day**

**Proposed Ordinance to Create and Administer Fire Lanes**

Motion by Alderman Bullermann to recommend to Council to cancel the September 10 Committee of the Whole and Common Council Meetings, due to the Primary Election held on the same day in the Council Chambers. Seconded by Alderman Harenda and carried unanimously.

**2002 Salary Range and Matrix Clarification**
