

This pamphlet has been created to inform residents of the City of New Berlin's Zoning Code Section 275-57 regarding inoperable vehicles.

It states:

"In all districts, no abandoned, dismantled, unlicensed, inoperative, wrecked, or junked vehicle or equipment, or a vehicle or equipments under repair or awaiting parts, shall be parked or stored for a period to exceed 30 days unless the vehicle is within a fully enclosed structure."

Inoperable Motor Vehicles



Inoperable Vehicles:

- ♦ May become a home for rodents, mosquitoes, insects and other vermin
- ♦ May become a fire hazard if they contain flammable substances
- ♦ May pose a danger to the public, particularly small children, due to loose, sharp, or jagged parts
- ♦ Contain fluids that, if leaked, may contaminate the environment

A number of options are available to owners of inoperable vehicles:

1. The vehicle may be placed in a closed garage.
2. You may call a local towing company and have the vehicle towed away.
3. Inoperable vehicles may be made operable, including updating registration.

This notice is provided to explain the City of New Berlin inoperable vehicle ordinance and is not a citation or written warning.

Please take the time to make sure any inoperable vehicles on your property are properly stored.
