RESOLUTION FOR LOCAL ENDORSEMENT OF THE YEAR 2035 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM PLAN FOR SOUTHEASTERN WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, which was duly created by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin in accordance with Section 66.0309(2) of the *Wisconsin Statutes* on the 8th day of August 1960, upon petition of the Counties of Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha, has the function and duty of making and adopting a master plan for the physical development of the Southeastern Wisconsin Region; and

WHEREAS, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission adopted on June 21, 2006, a transportation system plan for the development of the Region to the year 2035; and

WHEREAS, the year 2035 regional transportation system plan and the supporting inventories, analyses, objectives, principles, standards, and forecasts are set forth in a published report entitled SEWRPC Planning Report No. 49, *A Regional Transportation System Plan for Southeastern Wisconsin: 2035*; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has transmitted certified copies of its resolution adopting that transportation system plan, together with the aforementioned SEWRPC Planning Report No. 49, to the local units of government of the Southeastern Wisconsin Region; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Berlin Plan Commission has reviewed and believes that the transportation system plan prepared by the Commission will be a valuable guide not only to the development of the Region but of the city of New Berlin as well, and that the endorsement of such plan by the City of New Berlin Common Council will assure a common understanding by the several government levels and agencies concerned and enable their staffs to program the necessary area-wide and local plan implementation work, and;

WHEREAS, the City of New Berlin Plan Commission has reviewed and took action to approve the Plan & resolution at their meeting of November 5, 2007 and to forward the matter on to the Common Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the New Berlin Common Council on the 13th day of November, 2007, hereby endorses the regional transportation system plan for the year 2035, previously adopted by the Commission, as set forth in SEWRPC Planning Report No. 49 as a guide for regional and community development.

BE IT FURTHER HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Clerk transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission.
