COMMEMORATIVE TREE PROGRAM

The City of New Berlin Parks Department is sponsoring a Commemorative Tree Program. The purpose of the program is to allow citizens to have a tree planted within the New Berlin Park System or New Berlin Hills Golf Course. Since the start of the program in 1996, over 209 trees have been planted. There are a number of reasons to have a tree planted which include:

- Honoring the memory of a deceased relative, friend, or member of your organization.
- Giving a gift of gratitude or to commemorate a special day or event.
- Birth of a son, daughter or grandchild.
- Gift Trees are appropriate for all special occasions.

If you are interested in having a tree planted, simply contact the Parks Department and express your interest in the program. You may suggest a particular park area where you would prefer the tree to be planted.

The next step is to select a tree from the following available list:

AUTUMN BRILLIANCE SERVICEBERRY (*Amelanchier x grandiflora*) – an 8-ft tree is available for **\$156**
A multi-stem, shrub form tree with smooth grey bark. Clusters of hanging white flowers producing edible berries in early Summer. Outstanding orange to pink Fall color.

PRINCETON ELM (*Ulmus Americana 'Princeton'*) - 2 in. caliper is available for **\$145.00**
A vase shaped giant at maturity, reminiscent of a time before Dutch Elm Disease. This resistant variety has dark green foliage changing to a clear yellow and orange Fall color.

DONALD WYMAN FLOWERING CRABAPPLE (*Malus 'Donald Wyman'*) - 2 in. caliper available for **\$113.00**
This horizontal growing flowering crabapple produces pinkish buds to showy white flowers in Spring. The berries are bright red and persistent through the Winter providing additional interest and food for birds.

REGAL PRINCE ENGLISH OAK (*Quercus robur 'Regal Prince'*) - 1.75 in. caliper is available for **\$131.00**
This glossy green leaved tree has an oval to upright form and tight branching habit. It is considered fast growing among the oak trees and will mature to 30 feet tall and stately, living to be 300 years old.

SENTRY LINDEN (*Tilia Americana 'American Sentry'*) - 2.5 in. caliper available for **\$145.00**
Everything about this tree says bold. It has a nearly perfect pyramidal form at maturity nearing 60 feet tall. The Fall color is an eye catching gold and the spring flowers are slightly sweet attracting pollinators.

The Parks Department will purchase, plant and maintain the Commemorative Trees. The names of those honored and the names of the donors will be prominently displayed on a "Commemorative Tree Plaque" located in City Hall or the New Berlin Hills Golf Course Clubhouse. Recognition cards will be sent to all donors and the families of those being honored.

Trees make a community more attractive and increase the quality of life. They play an important part in shaping our attitude and state of mind. A gift of a tree provides a lasting commemorative and is a wonderful way to beautify New Berlin.
