Development Continues for 2016

The Prospect Creek Shopping Center is soon to open its first business in January. Arby's is expected to be open within the next 7 to 10 days to kick off the new development that will also include Panera Bread, Mattress Firm and Papa Johns. These businesses are expected to be finished later this winter or early spring. The Prospect Creek Shopping Center can be found near Moorland Road and I-43 near Firestone Complete Auto Care.

The Plan Commission will also be reviewing a Preliminary Plat for a proposed Kohler Ridge Subdivision at their January 6th meeting. The new subdivision includes a 47 lot conservation subdivision located near 21000 Lawnsdale Road, just west of Racine Avenue.
