Preparation for the November Election is in full swing at City Hall.

Absentee Ballots were mailed out on Wednesday, September 21st. Anyone that submitted an application should be receiving their ballot within two weeks. If you did apply for an absentee ballot and do not receive it by then, please contact the Clerks Office at, 262-786-8610.

If you still need to register please come to the City Clerks Office (before Friday, November 4th) or go to the New Berlin Public Library (before Wednesday, October 19th) and be sure to bring proof of residency with you.

If you would still like to receive an absentee ballot by mail please come to the City Hall to fill out an application (click [here](#) for more information), or visit MyVote (click [here](#)).

Early in-person voting will start here at City Hall, 3805 S Casper Dr., on Monday, October 17th and continue until Friday, November 4th. Please have your photo ID with you.
