Don't become a victim of a "Fraud by Wire" scam!

New Berlin Police Department



Typical "Fraud by Wire" Scenario:

1. Victim receives check for \$5,000 (can be any amount) to purchase items and as a hiring bonus (Secret Shopper Scam, Ziprecruiter, etc.)
2. Victim is sent an email or text message with instructions to verify they received the check
3. Victim is instructed to cash check or deposit the check into their bank account. (now they are out the money, usually 5 days later they will be notified the check is fake)
4. Victim is instructed to keep a portion of the deposited check (usually \$300) and transfer the remaining balance to a predetermined bank account.
5. After the victim completes this transaction they are sent an email or text to wait for further instructions.
6. Victim is later notified by the bank that the check is fake and they are now out the money for the amount the check was issued.
7. Victim reports the incident to the police department.
8. Police initiate an investigation and in most cases, are unable to recover the victim's money.



Snow Emergency

On Friday, December 16th, New Berlin declared a Snow Emergency. This was to reduce traffic congestion and ensure the orderly operation of emergency vehicles, including snow removal equipment and machinery. Steve Brooks, Streets Supervisor, Thanks the citizens for the patience and assistance while the Streets Department cleaned up the roads!



TAX BILL BREAKDOWN

The Schools receive \$0.55 out of a dollar, the City's portion is \$0.30, Waukesha Co. \$0.12, WCTC \$0.02 and the State receives the remaining \$0.01.
