Possible Police Impersonator Leads to Police Pursuit

Regarding the Big Bend PD possible police impersonator case that led to a pursuit:

All of the marked squads in New Berlin have "Official" plates, similar to municipal plates in color, but they put a star on our plates. All of our unmarked squads have regular looking plates. Here are several suggestions on what to do if you are not sure you are being stopped by a "real" police officer.

- 1) Pull over in a well-lit, public place if possible.
- 2) Don't roll you window down all the way, just enough to converse with the officer. Keep your door locked.
- 3) If the officer is not in uniform, ask him to call another officer to the location of the traffic stop that IS in uniform. 99% of all our traffic stops are made by uniformed officers.
- 4) If you are still in doubt, call our dispatcher at (262) 782-6640 and verify that a real New Berlin officer is stopping you. If it is an impersonator, he/she will probably take off pretty fast when they see you on the phone. If it's a real officer, they won't mind you calling. Our dispatcher also dispatches for Brookfield PD and Waukesha Sheriff, so if you are near a New Berlin border, it may be one of their squads. We also border Muskego, West Allis, Greenfield and Hales Corners, and our dispatcher does not dispatch for them. If an officer identifies himself as being from one of those departments, call the non-emergency number of that specific department to verify.
- 5) We sell all of our used squads at auction after taking off all of our equipment, except for the spotlight. Anyone can buy a used squad. It is easy to buy red and blue lights for a car. We see several old squads driving around our city all the time.
