

LANDMARK COMMISSION MINUTES

February 21, 2008

1. Meeting was called to order by Chairman DeMoss at 7:07. Attending Commissioners DeMoss, Wicichowski, Ament, Jashinsky, Pelkola, Hermann, Kampa and Alderman Poshepny.

Guests: Sue Hemmen and Joanne Erickson from the New Berlin Historical Society and Dolores Slane from Holy Apostles.

2. Motion by Commissioner Wicichowski to accept the minutes from the January 7, 2008 meeting with the addition of Commissioner Wicichowski is attendance. Seconded by Commissioner Ament and carried unanimously.

3. There was no balance shown on the Treasurer's report so we could not approve. Commissioner Wicichowski will check into this.

4. Communications from State Historical Society for a 2 day workshop in Wausau, Wisconsin for small museums at \$80.00 per person. It was decided that the cost was too much.

a. Our three guests were asked to speak first about the Cemetery Tour. Each one introduced themselves and told what they would do at the Cemetery. Joanne Erickson said she would work with Libbie Nolan (who sent along a copy for a handout at Sunnyside Cemetery that she wrote). Joanne will go over with her to see what residents they will talk about. Sue Hemmen told about the stones and the symbols on them, we could include this in a handout for visitors. She brought in pictures of some of the stones and talked about how other places give their tours. She will work up something on who she will talk about. Dolores Slane is working on having a few seventh and eighth graders give the tour at Holy Apostles. It will be a learning experience for them. She will also talk about the Time Capsule that was placed during the 1976 Bicentennial. We also discussed the following ideas:

We should list who the prominent people are in each Cemetery.

We decided not to use actors this first year.

Will try to get Flags placed on Soldiers Graves

Have donation boxes on the Busses and explain who the money is going to.

Commissioner Pelkola will get the tour listed in the Holy Apostles bulletin.

We should put this on the School's e-mail that goes home with the children.

Our guests should come back to the April 17th meeting with finalized information.

Alderman Harenda talked about the Preserve America Grant, and explained who all has to approve. Deadline is May 1st. In kind donations can be used for the matching portion.

b. Commissioner Jashinsky has two versions for the signage on the old Post Office sign. It will be discussed at the next meeting.

c. Progress is being made on getting permission for driveway use. A meeting will be held on March 4th.

d. Commissioner Kampa will try to see who she has to contact before she can go further on getting prices, etc. for the Glockenspiel Clock Tower.
