Commemorative Tree Program

The City of New Berlin Parks Department will purchase, plant, and maintain the trees in the New Berlin Park System and New Berlin Hills Golf Course.

Names of those honored or memorials and the names of the donors will be prominently displayed on the Commemorative Tree Plaque located in the lobby of City Hall or in the Clubhouse at New Berlin Hills Golf Course.

All donors, those honored or the families of memorials will be notified by mail after the tree is planted.

The tree will be tagged with a temporary plastic ribbon identifying it as a commemorative tree. There is also an optional brick that can be purchased (engraved with name of person honored).

Commemorative Tree Program

Select a tree from the following list:

Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry (Amelanchier x grandiflora) – 1-1/2” caliper available for **\$200**.

A beautiful smaller stature tree with smooth grey bark. Clusters of hanging white flowers producing edible berries in early summer. Outstanding orange to pink fall color.

New Horizon Elm (Ulmus “New Horizon”) – 1-3/4” caliper available for **\$175**.

This variety has an excellent resistance to Dutch elm disease, grows to a height of 40 feet tall, and is an outstanding parkway and shade tree.

Royal Raindrops Crabapple (Malus Royal Raindrops Crabapple) – 1-1/2” caliper available for **\$205**.

One of the prettiest purple-leaved crabapples, also with bright fall color. Masses of magenta pink flowers appear in mid spring. All around fantastic ornamental tree.

Hybrid Swamp x Burr Oak (Quercus x schuettei) – available for **\$200**.

A hybrid between a burr oak and a swamp white oak. It's a medium sized conical shade tree that is adaptable to a variety of site conditions. With age it rounds and broadens out. 40-60' tall. A good choice in parks and as a future shade tree.

Early Glow Buckeye (Aesculus glabra) available for **\$210**.

Beautiful yellow-green spring flowers, & early bright red fall make the Early Glow Buckeye a great ornamental interest in a park or public setting. It can reach 35 feet tall, by 35 feet wide. This is a good all-around ornamental and shade tree at maturity.

The Parks Department will purchase, plant and maintain the Commemorative Trees. The names of those honored and the names of the donors will be prominently displayed on a “Commemorative Tree Plaque” located in City Hall or the New Berlin Hills Golf Course Clubhouse. There is also an optional brick that can be purchased (engraved with the name of the person honored) to be placed by the Commemorative Tree. Recognition cards will be sent to all donors and the families of those being honored.

Trees make a community more attractive and increase the quality of life. They play an important part in shaping our attitude and state of mind. A gift of a tree provides a lasting commemorative and is a wonderful way to beautify New Berlin.
